### What age and type of children do you serve?

### Is Alpha state funded?

No, Alpha is 100% privately funded through the financial support of churches, individuals, businesses and groups interested in partnering with us to help provide for children in need.

### Is Alpha non-profit?

Yes, Alpha is a 501(c)3 incorporated, nonprofit organization governed by a board of directors.

### Is there a fee?

No, only if funds are available or the family can afford to help. We do not charge a tuition fee.
